THE WEIGHTED WHEEL.

Use a weighted wheel to determine if your'e better off playing your horse to win, or on top in exotics. Here is an example. It is a six-horse race and you like program number six. Here is what the exactas are paying with the six on top of the other horses:

Now ask yourself how many times you would have to have any one of the above exactas to get back \$100 if the six wins. Those numbers are in the third column. For example, you would have to have a 6-1 exacta seven times to get back \$100. If it came in 6-5 you would only need one ticket.

Now figure out what it costs to buy all those exactas. Simply multiply the number of tickets needed by two and add it all up. In this simple case we can see that to play the six on top of all the other horses and guarantee a return of \$100 (if the six wins of course), costs \$36. This means that the six is 9-5 in the exacta pool. Here's the math on that: \$36 returns \$100 which nets a profit of \$64. Divide 64 by 36 and you get 1.8. Another way of expressing 1.8 to 1 is 18 to 10, or 9 to 5.

Alternately you could figure out what you would have to bet to win to get back \$100. If the win price was 3-1 then you would have to bet \$25 to get back \$100, and then of course you would be better off playing this horse to win than in exactas.

Use weighted wheels to figure out whether to bet exactas, doubles, or to win. Also weighted wheels can help you figure out what the final win odds are likely to be if it's still early in the betting. F'rinstance, at Calder Race Course the win odds very rarely 'gel' till about two to three minutes to post. Until that time most of the contenders are often sitting at odds of about 5-2. However, the horse that is favored in the exactas will usually end up the posttime favorite. Use a weighted wheel to see who is being bet in the exactas.

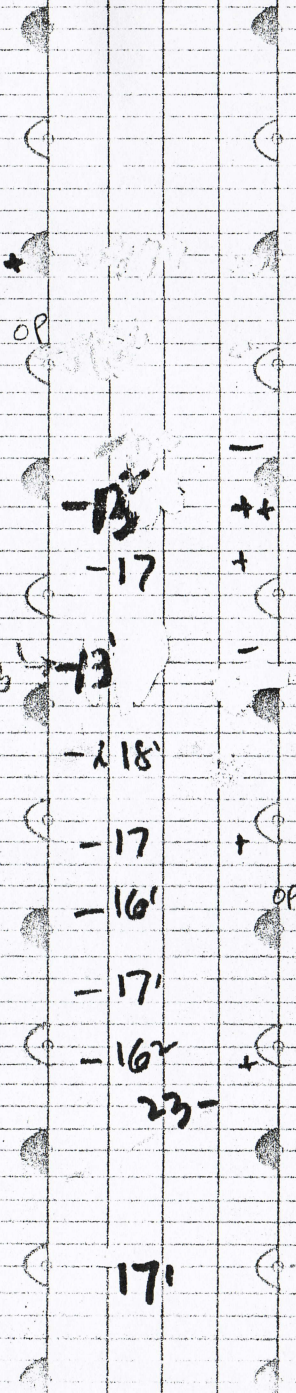

SAM THE LION, off slowly, rallied between horses after entering the stretch but hung. NEPHRITE, well placed early, moved back to the inside after going around SEATTLE KNIGHT nearing the stretch but weakened under pressure. WASICHUS rallied approaching the stretch and tired. FOND ENCOUNTER showed some early foot while racing wide. MACEO was always outrun. SEATTLE KNIGHT gave way soon after going a half. COURT M. P. showed brief speed.

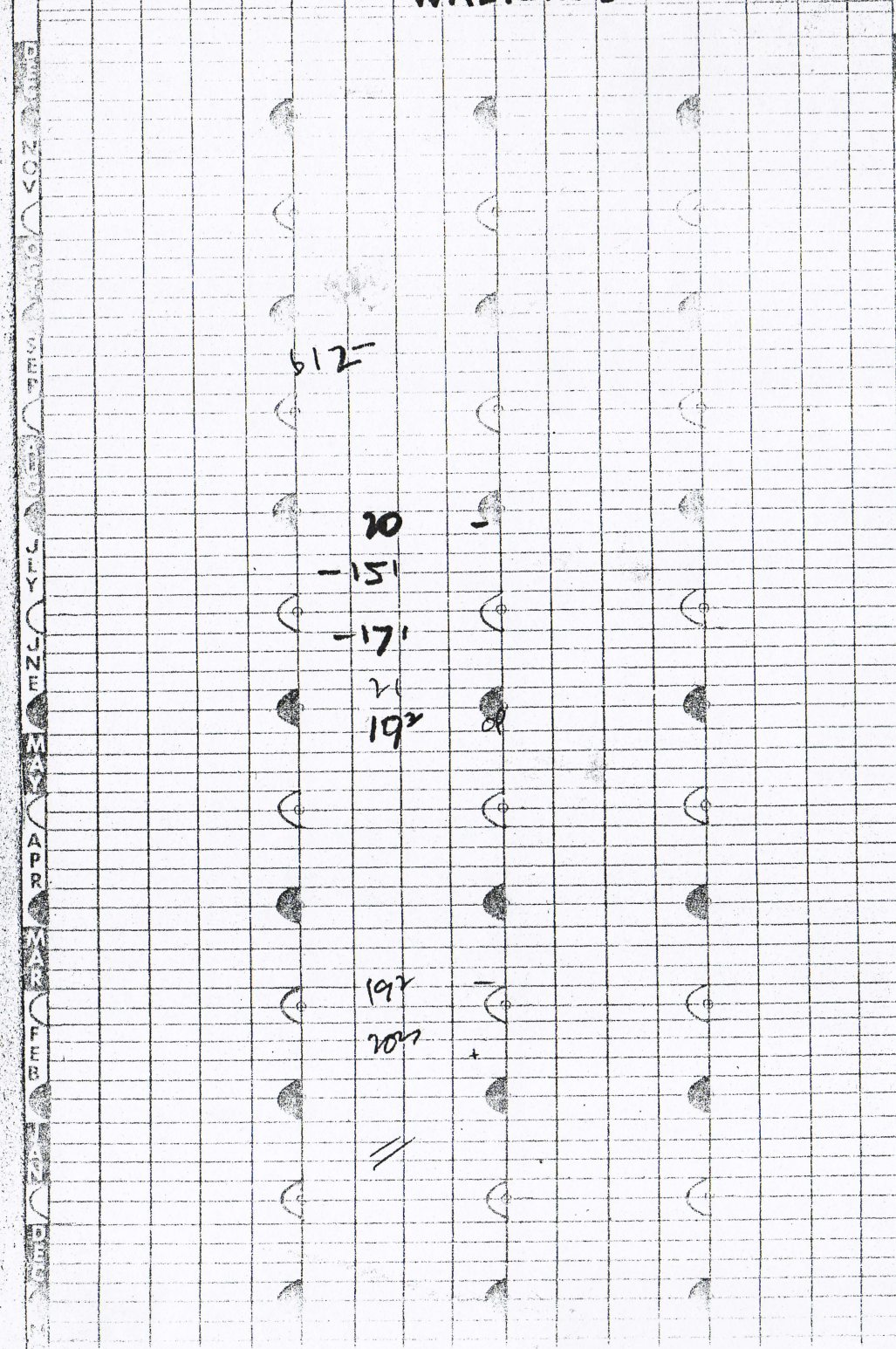
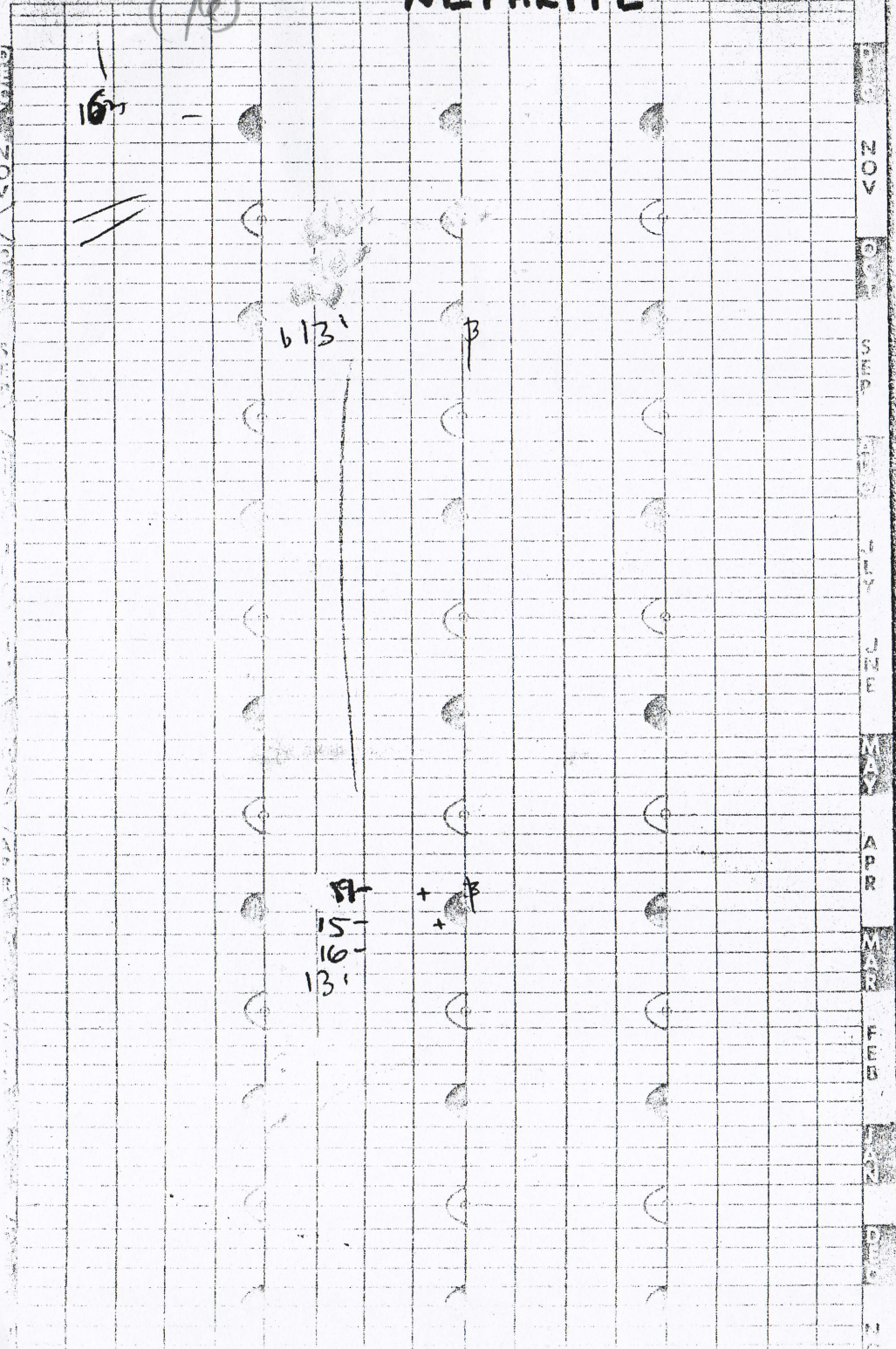

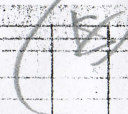
